- Collaborate with CanNor and ITI in traditional economy development (Phase II).
- Participate in NWT Board Forum meetings.

- Participate in development of new Bathurst Caribou management body.
- Participate in Conference of Management Authorities and Species At Risk Committee, and undertake engagements with RRCs on activities related to implementation of the Species At Risk Act.
