Federal government is understaffed and response was delayed until July.

Catarina Owen provided an update on status of Mackenzie Valley Highway Environmental Assessment and Imperial Oil Type A water Licence.

EBA was company contracted to do Mackenzie Valley Highway TK study.

SRRB staff will check Mackenzie Valley Highway TK study to make sure correct method and approach were applied. SRRB will involved RRCs for TK validation.

a. Conoco Phillips TK study

Deb Simmons explained how SRRB become the organization in charge of managing Conoco Phillips TK study (TRRC was going through a transition period and asked SRRB to help)

Only document completed at this point is the Intern Report, no new information has been submitted and TRRC is custodial of information. TRRC is now managing CPC TK study and will be the organization validating TK study.

- Limited funding (traditional and scientific research) in SSA restricting communities and SRRB in determining impacts of development activities

Conclusion from presentation: The SRRB feels the above items and outstanding public concerns with the Mackenzie Gas Project Environmental Assessment to warrant its referral to a joint panel review.
