Community conservation planning updates

Délinę Belare Wíle Gots'é ?ekwé Plan

- Letter was received from Déline Got'ine Government formally recognizing and supporting collaborative implementation of the community 2ekwé conservation plan, and requesting a meeting with the SRRB.
- The most recent meeting of the Déline ?ekwé Working Group involved a discussion of the harvest in order to comply with the plan. This was a challenging process, in part since there were challenges in working cooperatively with the local ENR office to achieve consensus. The SRRB had to deliver a letter to ENR about our understanding of the harvest based on all the information that we have received.
- There has been an SRRB recommendation for ENR officer training to support them in understanding their role in a community conservation planning process.
- The next step for the Déline ?ekwé Working Group is for them to fill in the ACCWM's status assessment table while the winter/spring harvest is still fresh in people's minds, and as a basis for discussion among communities and regions prior to the ACCWM status assessment in November.

Colville Lake Caribou Management Plan

- Colville has submitted a draft Caribou Management Plan to ENR Minister Robert C. McLeod, copy to the SRRB.
- We are coordinating with Colville to meet with them to discuss the plan at our next inperson meeting; they have requested that the meeting take place in Yellowknife.
