Winter Lennie, Chairman, SRRB, opened the conference call meeting at 1:10 p.m. He informed the Board of all attendees, and the agenda items to be discussed.

SIGNING AUTHORITY - NORMAN SIMONS (EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR)

MOTION #001/09/99

"THAT NORMAN SIMMONS BE GIVEN SIGNING AUTHORITY ON BEHALF OF THE SAHTU RENEWABLE RESOURCES BOARD".

All in favour. Motion passed unanimously.

JAMES KUSHNY - POSITION

- SRRB being sued for breach of contract.
- Winter, (with the advice of lawyer), suggested that the Board ship James' household goods back south.
- Second letter of offer, 21/08/99, (written by Jim Moore), recommended that James complete his Master's degree within one year, that evaluations will be conducted quarterly and probationary period will be one year.
- Letter dated 3/09/99 was based primarily on the verbal agreement made with Jim Moore and Winter Lennie.
- Response was received from James' lawyer 15/09 stating that he would not be coming to work for the SRRB and that it would be liable to an action for anticipatory breach of contract.
- Norm informed the Board that a Master's degree could not be completed with one year, as stated by James.
- Winter informed the Board that James household goods (without prejudice) are being shipped back to Toronto by Matco, and spoke on a defense stand.

(At this time, Cyntha Levy, Davis & Company lawyer, was connected to the conference call).

- Winter questioned Cynthia on the defense.
- Cynthia informed the Board that she had no idea on demands from James' lawyer; that she acknowledges a claim for breach of contract.
- Celina stated that she has back up documents from the University of Alberta.
- Cynthia informed that the Board has to wait for further word from James' lawyer.

BIOLOGIST/HARVEST STUDY CO-ORDINATOR

- Positions are still not filled. Norm suggested that these positions be contracted out on a short term basis of six months. They would be required to train Janet and Rosa.
- Discussion. Board agrees with Norm that these positions be advertised as soon as possible.

STRATEGIC PLAN

- Winter informed that a consultant will be hired to draw up job descriptions, appraisal forms, and a training plan (career development) for the staff.
- Norm to check with Tom Williams. Also, to check with Mike Bell if interested in facilitating the Strategic Planning Meeting. He also feels that there is a need for a Board Management course.
- Winter will keep the Board updated on the progress of this issue.
