
Pełets'éhkwę Godí Key Questions

Procedural Direction

"Hot topics" in caribou conservation through a five-part PLS series

Each PLS is one hearing

The 5-part PLS series will be 5 hearings





- What are the impacts of climate change and wildfires on people, caribou and caribou habitat?
- How do caribou respond to climate change and wildfires?
- What mitigation and adaptation should occur for climate change and wildfires related to caribou conservation?
- How can Hıdó Gogha Sénégots'ı pá (Planning for the Future PFF) reflect and respond to climate change and wildfires?
- O What is the minimum content for a Hidó Gogha Sénégots' 17 à (Planning for the Future PFF) process and written plan?




- Purpose of gathering:


