The ʔehdzo Got'ıne Gots'é Nákedı (Sahtú Renewable Resources Board – SRRB), Déljné Got'ıne Government and Déljné ʔehdzo Got'ıne (Renewable Resources Council) are extending a special invitation to Sahtú organisations and NWT Environment and Natural Resources to participate in a Community Conservation Planning workshop on **September 14-16, 2021** in Déljné. **The deadline for registrations is August 20.**

Three to five delegates are invited per community panel, including at least one youth delegate. The SRRB is preparing contribution agreements for ʔehdzo Got'ıne (Renewable Resources Councils) to cover the cost of honoraria as well as other preparation/participation costs for the Déljné 2021 Public Listening Session. The SRRB will arrange travel, and Déljné will coordinate catering and billets.

The purpose of the workshop is to support leading representatives of each Sahtú community to prepare materials that can be used at the Public Listening Session (PLS) on the topic of ***Tłch'ádıı he Gots'edı: Living with Wildlife: Caribou Predators and Competitors*** on November 16-18, 2021.

This workshop will be a valuable opportunity to strengthen and support Sahtú community conservation plans for wildlife, with a focus on “hot topics” for the Déljné 2021 PLS. Participants will also be able to develop questions that would be helpful to have answered in preparation for the November PLS. They will receive training so that they can confidently work with members of their community to prepare for the PLS.
