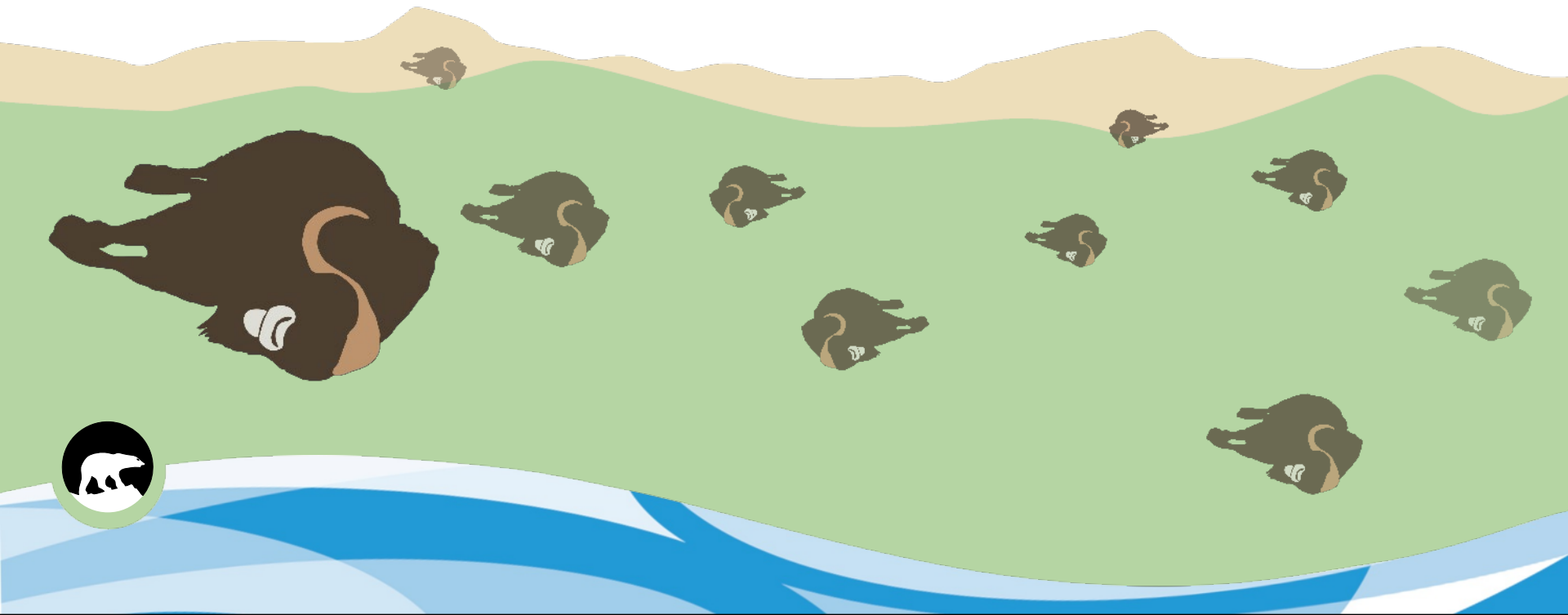








Less than 1 in 10 disease cases are
found using current monitoring methods



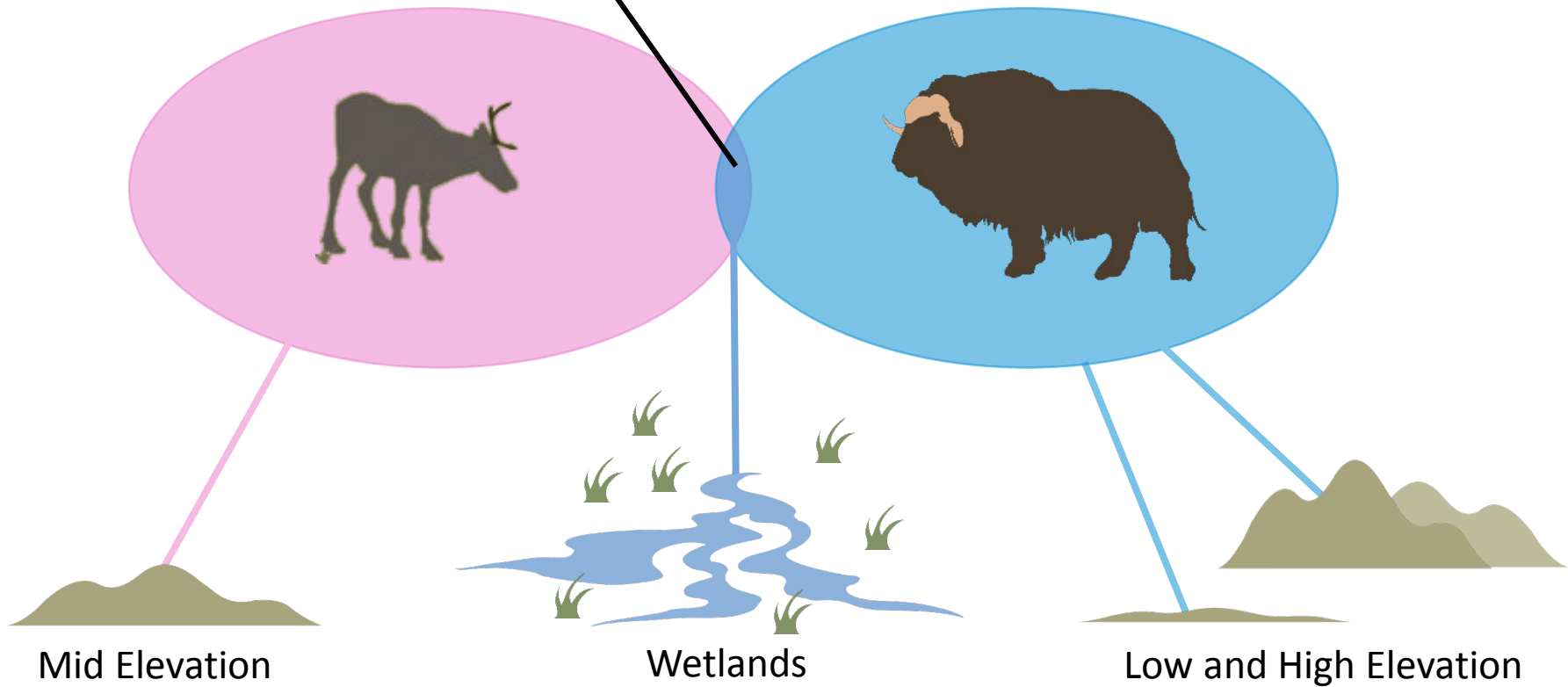

Bluenose east herd has declined by about 78%

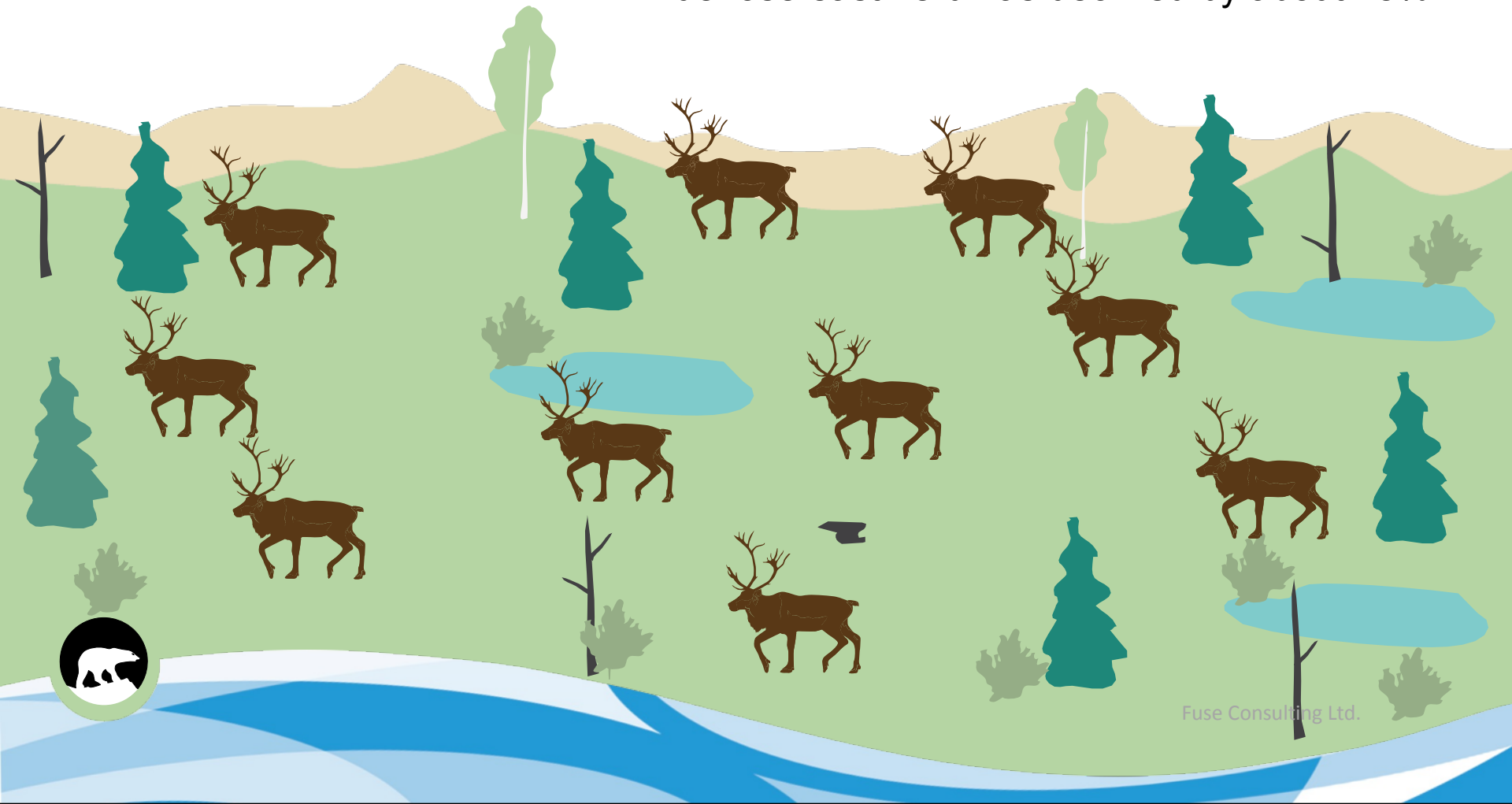
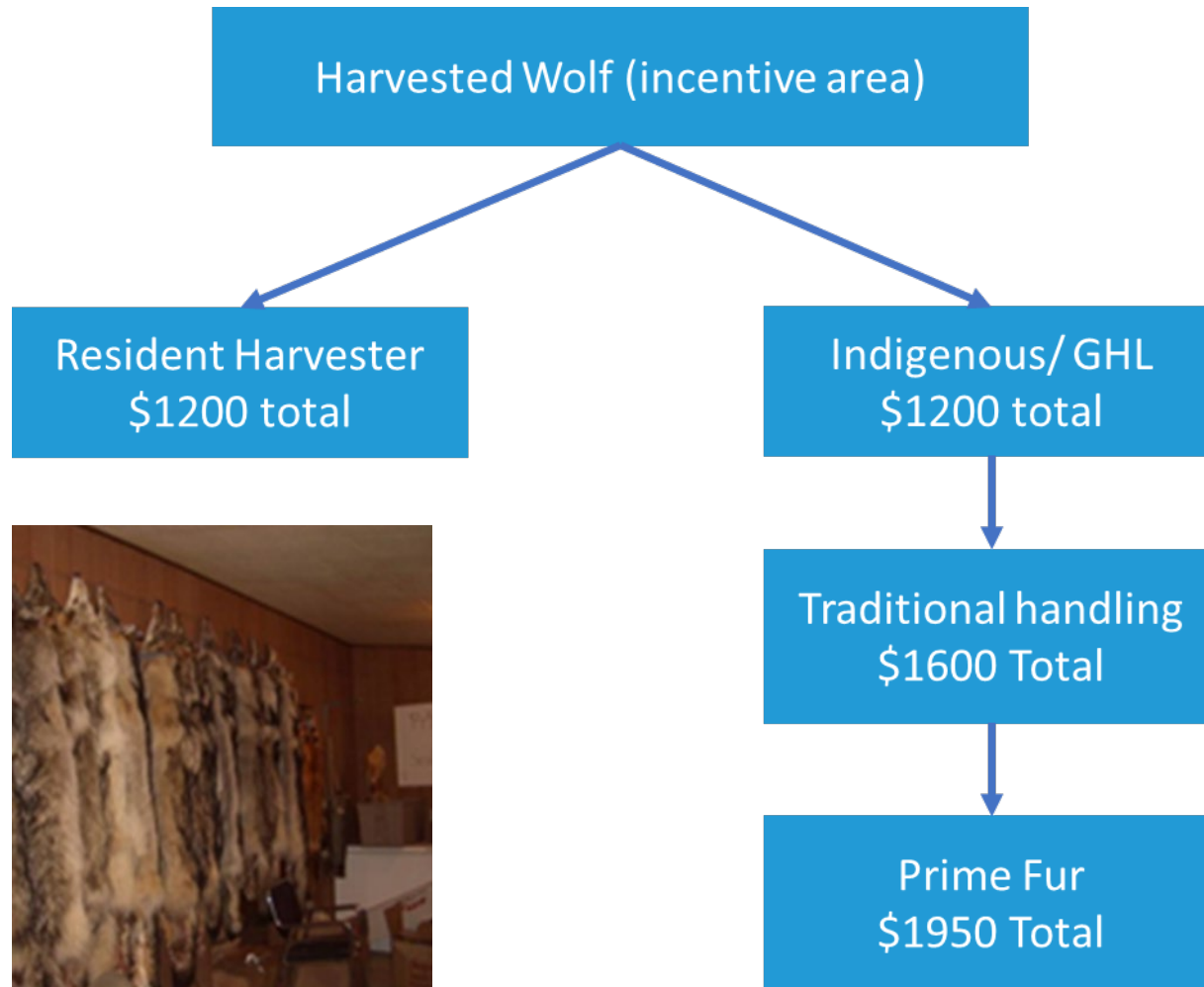

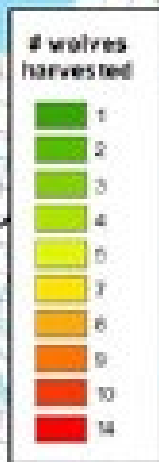

Area of Inuit traditional use area

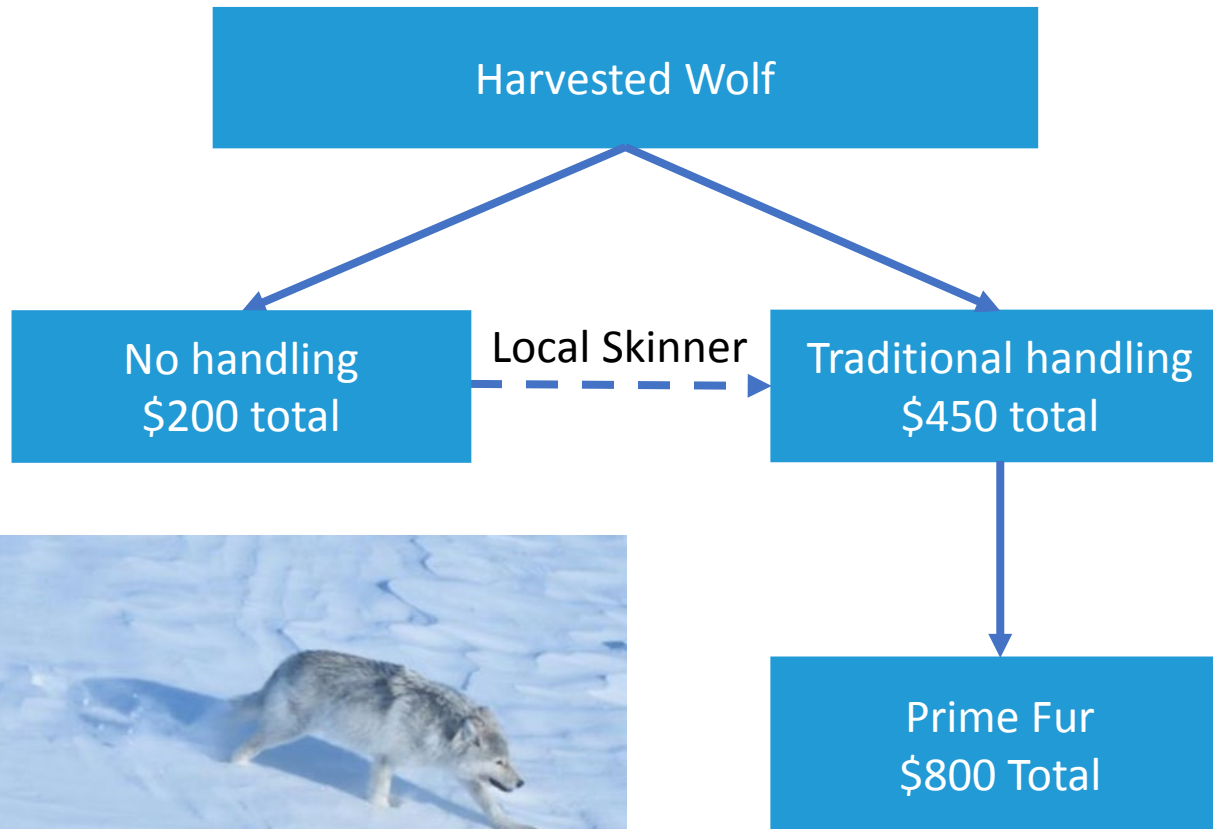

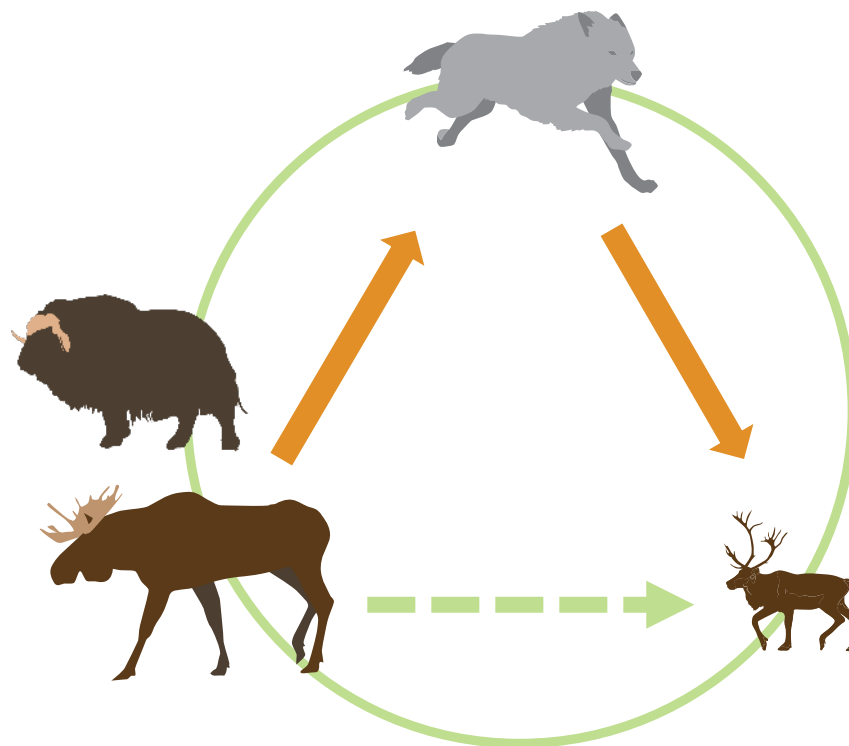
