Policy Statement

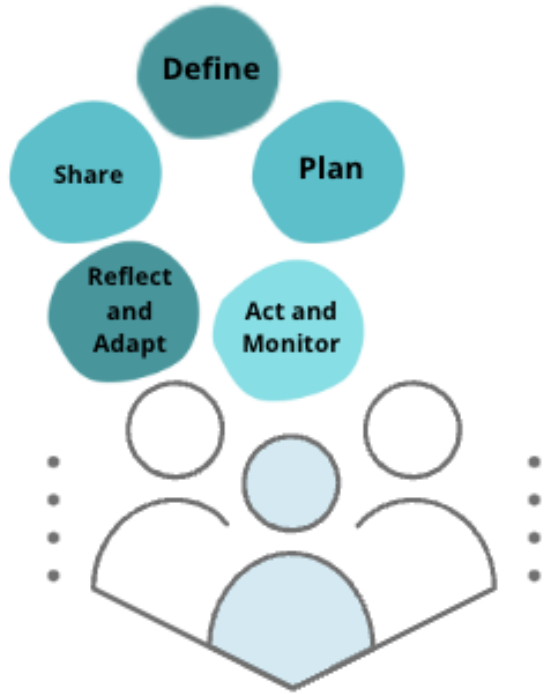
- Viable conservation approaches that can be more effective, more rights-compliant and community-led alternatives to harvest limits.
- Community-based, rights-compliance governance frameworks, reflecting and respecting local customs and practices.
- Should be the priority response to wildlife conservation concerns in the Sahtú region.

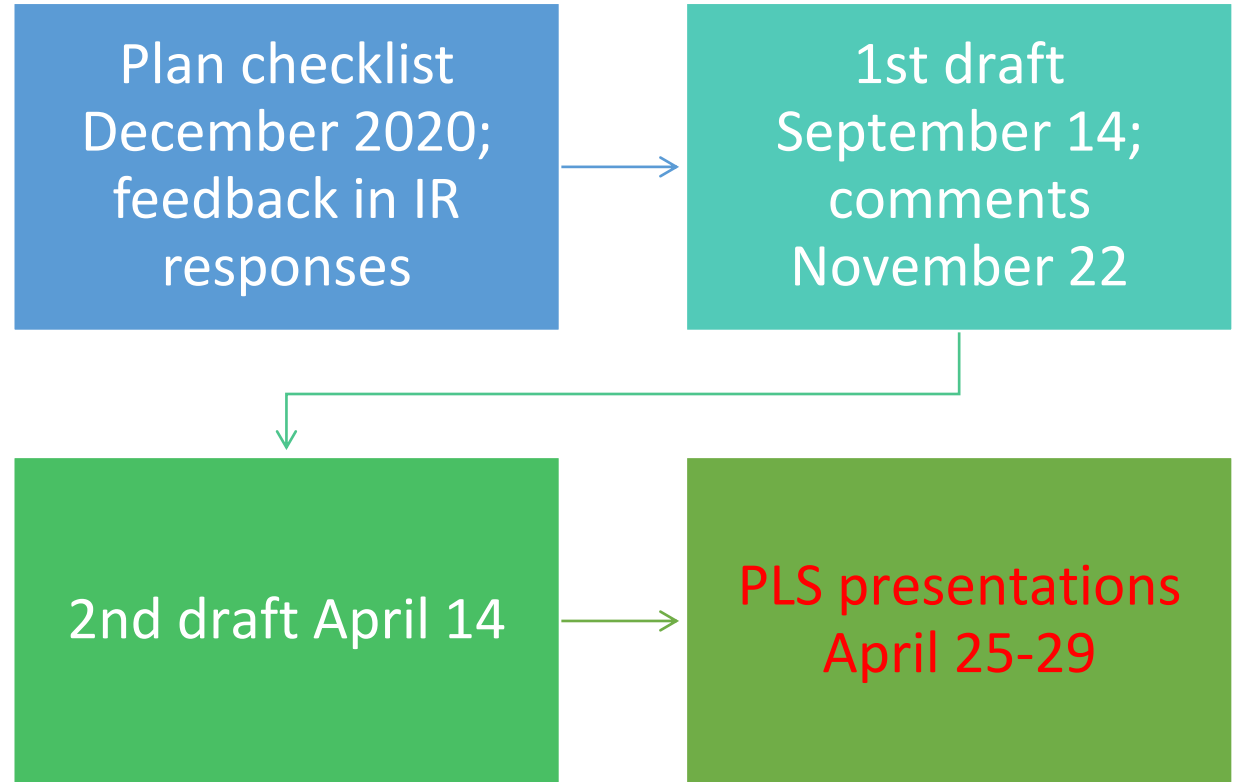

Jurisdiction

- PLS is called as a hearing
- PLS helps SRRB make decisions about wildlife
- Ultimate authority in law lies with GNWT Minister

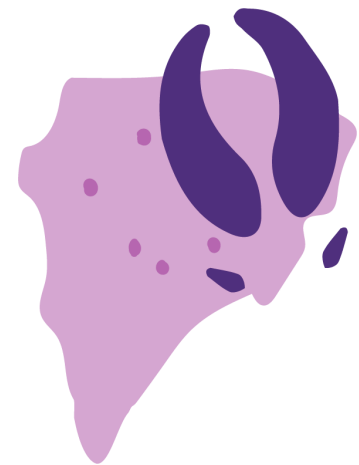

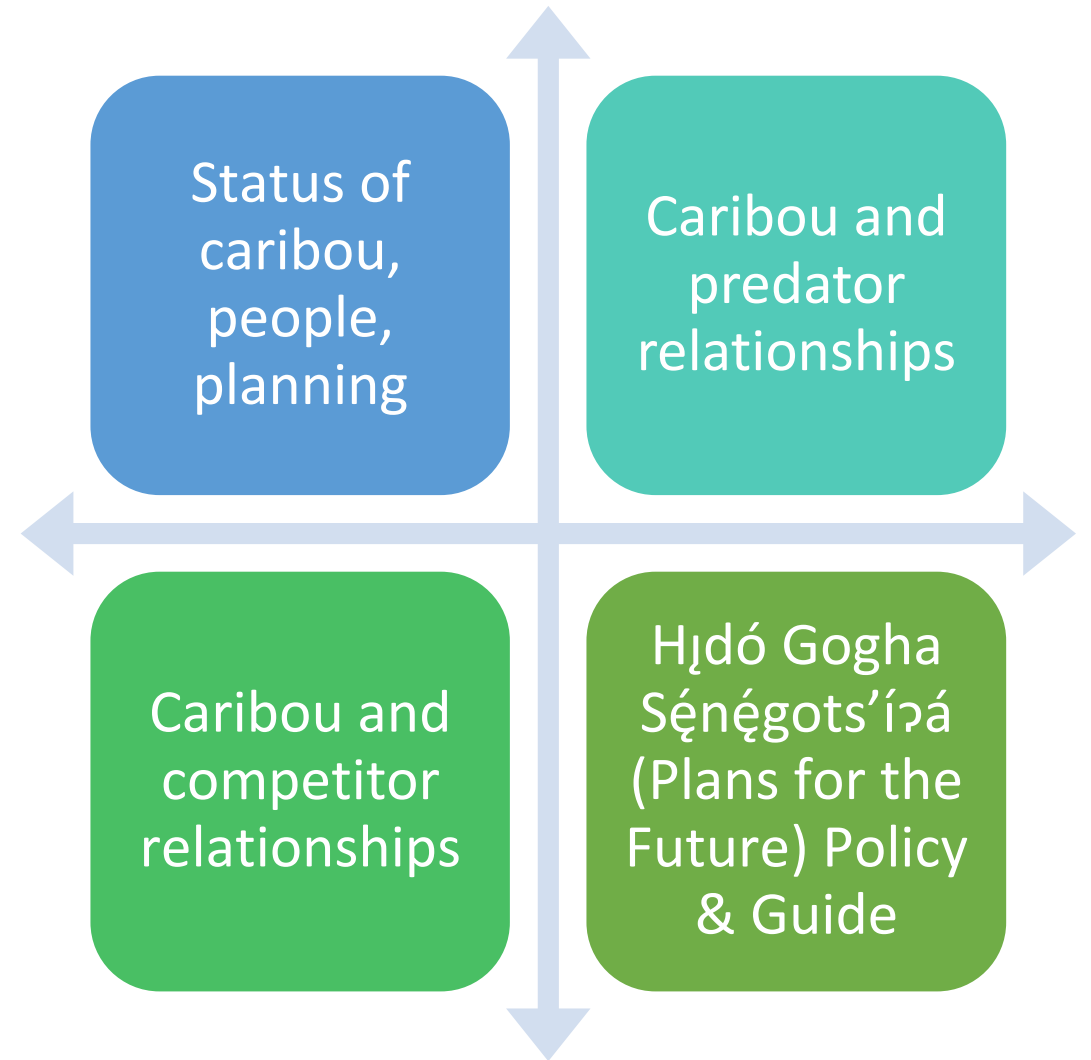

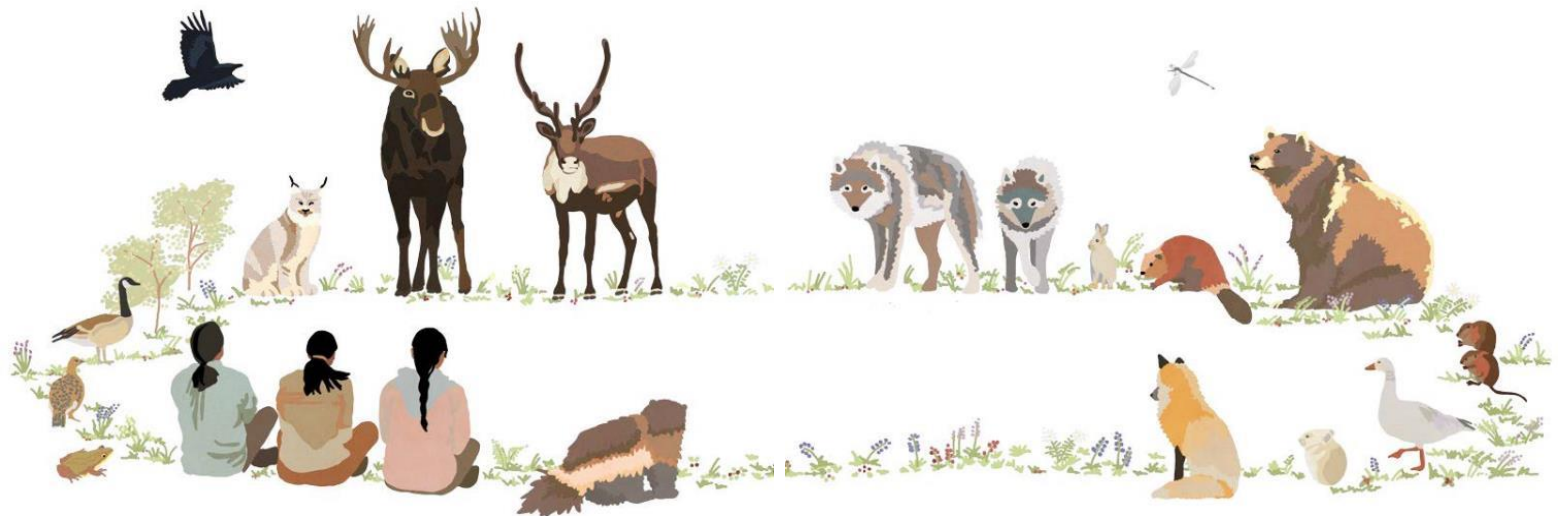
