Background

On May 23-24 at a joint meeting of the Délįnę Got'įnę Government, Délįnę ?ehdzo Got'įnę, SRRB, and ENR it was decided to re-establish the ?ekwę́ Working Group to provide oversight for implementation of the *Belare Wile Gots'ę́ ?ekwę́* plan. Three meetings of the ?ekwę́ Working Group were held with ENR representatives on August 29-30, September 10-11 and 20 to update the *Belare Wile Gots'ę́ ?ekwę́* plan, reflecting community concerns about the reduced availability of ?ehdaįla ?ekwę́. The following workplan reflects discussions of the Working Group as well as objectives identified during earlier phases of plan implementation.

The workplan is structured according to the program areas defined in the plan, and includes a brief status update for ongoing priorities. Note that as with previous years, the Working Group is prioritizing three of the four program areas identified in the plan for 2019-2020 – and planning forward for future activities related to the fourth program area
