Changed Report Timeline

Notice to Sahtú leaders, Parties, and neighbours, April 6, 2020

The ?ehdzo Got'ınę Gots'ę́ Nákedı (Sahtú Renewable Resources Board – SRRB) regrets to inform the Parties and the public that due to disruptions caused by the COVID-19 pandemic, the Board has decided to change the timeline for delivery of the Colville 2020 Public Listening Report to the Minister of Environment and Natural Resources by one month, to April 30, 2020.

The Board reminds Parties in the hearing that section 13.8.24(b) of the *Sahtú Dene and Métis Comprehensive Land Claim Agreement* (SDMCLCA) provides that, unless the Minister directs otherwise, the SRRB's Final Report will remain confidential for a period of 60 days, or until June 29, 2020.
